

Recreation: Naples' Burgunder finishes 67th in 21K race in Hawaii

NAPLES — Two Naples residents completed the XTERRA Trail Running World Championship 21K in Hawaii.

Richard Burgunder placed 67th overall in Sunday's event, finishing in 1 hour, 52 minutes. He placed fourth out of 36 in the 30-34 age group. Angel King finished in 2:05 and was sixth of 23 in the 25-29 age bracket.

Shark run: The Shark Shootout 5K is Saturday at Tiburón Golf Club at The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort in Naples.

The course is along the interior roads of the Tiburón residential development.

Registration is from 6 to 7 a.m., and start time is 7:15 a.m. Advance registration is \$25 and race-day registration \$30. Cost is \$10 for children 18 and younger. Registration includes one daily grounds ticket to the Shootout.

Complimentary parking is at the Shootout's general spectator lot at the intersection of Airport-Pulling Road and Orange Blossom Drive. Shuttles will be provided to the event location. Packet pickup is from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. today and Friday at Naples On The Run, 2116 9th St. N. or at 6 a.m. at the race site on race day.

The run benefits CureSearch National Childhood Cancer Foundation.

FGCU run: The inaugural Resolution Run 2009 will be Dec. 31 at Alico Arena on the Florida Gulf Coast University campus.

The 5K road race and 1-mile fun run will benefit the FGCU Tri-Eagles, Gulf Coast Swim Team and Pinewoods School Classroom on Wheels.

The fun run begins at 3 p.m., the 5K at 3:30 p.m. Participants receive a T-shirt and refreshments. Participants in the 5K are eligible to receive overall and age group awards.
